VOLUNTARY TRAVEL ID

New license approved for U.S. air travel and military base entry



ARRIVAL IN THE MAIL

Will arrive in the mail 5-10 business days after applying



IDENTITY VERIFICATION

Present documentation when applying with Circuit Court Clerk



EXTENDED SHELF LIFE

Initial choice of 4- or 8-year lifespan for licenses and IDs



NEW PRICING

Accounts for extended lifespan and enhanced security

Both card versions are acceptable for driving, voting, age-restricted purchases and accessing federal and social benefit services

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

U.S. citizens/permanent residents requesting a Voluntary Travel ID credential—or first-time applicants requesting any credential—will need to present documentation at the Circuit Court Clerk office in their county of residence. For a full list of documents, visit drive.ky.gov. A 30-day temporary credential will be issued until the permanent card arrives in the mail.

NOTICE: If your current legal name, date of birth, or gender is different than what is displayed on your identity or lawful status document, you must show legal proof of the changes (i.e. marriage license).

One (1) proof of **identity**

Certified birth certificate, passport, permanent resident card, etc. (Applicants under 18 must provide birth certificate)

Two (2)* proofs of **residency**



Utility bill, salary statement, etc. Must be less than 61 days old
*One (1) proof needed for new standard

One (1) proof of **Social Security**



Non-laminated Social Security card or current tax year W-2 form

REMEMBER!

As long as Kentucky maintains a federal extension until Oct. 1, 2020, residents may continue to use new standard or current licenses, permits or IDs for U.S. air travel and restricted federal facility entry. Starting Oct. 1, 2020, residents will need a Voluntary Travel ID credential for those purposes.

NEW PRICING

Applicants 21 and older may choose an 8-year license or ID, or a 4-year license or ID for half the cost. Starting spring 2023, all licenses and IDs will be valid 8 years.

NOTICES: CDL costs vary with type and endorsements, and will only be issued with 8-year lifespans; for pricing, call (502) 564-1257. To replace a lost or stolen card is \$15. Non-U.S. citizens applying or renewing (standard only) will pay a \$30 application fee at any Division of Driver Licensing Regional Field Office.
